

Jane Muus (10.6.1919-12.7.2007)

- *I would like to introduce the art works of my late aunt, Jane Muus.* -

Jane Muus was a Danish illustrator and graphic artist, trained at the Royal Academy 1936-44 under Aksel Jørgensen.

Jane Muus has predominantly portrayed people, at times in intense portraits, sometimes during numerous trips in everyday life on the streets, markets and cafes.

Her form of expression is simplified realism, often marked by humor and subtlety, she uses techniques like woodcut. This can be seen in her important work as a book illustrator, such as Charles Dickens' *A Christmas Carol in Prose* (1946) and the short stories of Herman Bang (1966).

Jane Muus was a member of Corner 1965, Kammeraterne 1970. She has received the Eckersberg Medal (1968) and Thorvaldsen Medal (1984).
